Advaita Vedanta, Vyakran, Jyotish, Mimansa, Nyaya and Sahitya will be subjects for this training program


- Students will be selected based on an All India Entrance Test, which will be conducted on 6th February, 2016 at Varanasi, Kolkata, Bhopal, Tirupati, Somnath, Jammu, Agartala, Nagpur and Shringeri from 11.00 A.M to 2.00 P.M. Students studying in Acharya/M.A. or Vidyavaridhi/Ph.D. are eligible for attending the entrance test.
- Interested students may apply in prescribed format via email over the Email Id shastrarthatraining@gmail.com latest by 01.02.2016.
- The participants have to report to the centre I/C of the centre concerned along with their photo id. Proof, one hour before the commencement of the exam.
- List of the selected students will be displayed on the Sansthan's website on 15.2.2016 at 6.00 Pm.
- Late received and incomplete application shall not be entertained.
- The students participating in the above test will not be entitled for T.A/D.A etc .
- The students selected for the Shastrartha Training Program will be entitled for train fare up to A.C. third class from their home station to Howrah railway station and back to the home station along with Rs. 300 per day as journey D.A.
- Air fare of economy class from Kolkata to Agartala and to return same route will also be provided for the participants.
- Boarding and Lodging will be provided from 1st March to 23rd March, 2016.
- Evaluation on the basis of written test, oral and Shastrarthavichar will be made at the end of every week as well as at the end of the program.
- All the successful trainees (with an aggregate of 60% or more marks) will be issued merit certificate.
- Medium of instruction, communication and evaluation will be Sanskrit only.
